What is it? It's a job for the PEOPLE to whom you and I owe a debt that can never be repaid. They're the men and women in more than 130 Veterans Affairs (VA) facilities (hospitals and convalescent centers located all across the country).

What is the Job? Doing whatever we can to stamp CANCELLED across the face of the deadliest foe the hospitalized service personnel must fight - ENFORCED IDLENESS and its deadly allies: *boredom, loneliness, frustration, futility, and despair.*

What can stamps do? *Miracles, almost. Stamps can give the patients, long-treatment patients, and convalescent patients, a consuming interest. They can sort stamps without effort as they lie in bed. If they are ambulatory, or even in a wheelchair, they can pass happy hours soaking stamps and putting them in albums. Even the far withdrawn, mentally disabled patient takes pleasure in using the more common stamps to make fanciful greeting cards, or to cover decorative boxes in organized therapy sessions.*

What stamps are wanted? *U.S. and foreign, in any quantity.*

What stamps are not wanted? *Torn, damaged or defective stamps.*

Now You've Decided to Help... A few suggestions: *Be SURE to leave at least a quarter-inch margin or paper around stamps. Please DON'T try to peel or steam stamps off! Don't soak stamps or sort them into packets. This work is much of the fun for the hospitalized collector!*

Limited Liability Company, LLC, Takeover of Communities

As the present time there are LLCs operating in the Pasco County Florida that have taken over or trying to takeover communities and converting them to rental properties.

One complete takeover has occurred at Forest Lake while attempts are presently ongoing at Betmar and Colony Hills.

Grand Horizons HOA has been in contact with our attorney who has recommended that we amend our current Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws and Declaration of Covenants to prevent such a takeover from ever occurring.

Proposed amendments will be sent out to every member for their consent to amend the documents. It is imperative that all members give their signed consent to amend our governing documents. Each governing document requires the approval of two-thirds of the members to amend the document. That means for our documents to be amended 234 member must give their consent for each document.

Happy New Year!

As we start 2020 I would like to remind everyone of couple things to keep in mind for the safety and well-being of our friends and neighbors in our community:

Walking your pet: Dogs need to be leashed at all times when outdoors. Also, if the puppy needs to do their business it should be on your **own** yard and not that of your neighbor. And if you are walking your dog and they accidentally leave a little "New Year's Gift" on someone's yard, please pick it up. Also, pet owners, when walking your beloved pets please remember the roads here do have a limit on how wide they are. So keep your four legged fur babies on a leash and under control, especially if there are any vehicles approaching. A sudden change in direction by your pet could be very dangerous. MAILINGS FROM HOA:

1. Shed Proposal Consent:

This mailing was done the end of November regarding building a shed on back patio of community center. The shed would be used mainly by the social club to hold decorations; many of which have been stored in a resident's garage. If you agree to building this shed, please sign and return your consent form to the HOA. We need consent forms from 2/3 of total voting interest by February 23 in order for this proposal to pass.

2. Annual Membership Meeting Notice:

This mailing was created December 12. It contains the required notice for the membership meeting to be held on January 30, 2020. Three new directors for the HOA board will be installed; there will not be an election since the number of candidates matched equally the number of vacancies.

If you are unable to attend this meeting, please fill out and return the proxy that is enclosed in the mailing. We cannot hold this meeting unless we have a quorum of member's either 'in person' or 'by proxy'; therefore it is really important you either come to the meeting or sign and return your proxy so that you are counted. Your participation is greatly appreciated.

3. Governing Documents Mailing:

This mailing should be ready and mailed before the holidays. There is a great need to update our governing documents to match changes already done to the Florida Statute. In addition, we are changing some verbiage to protect our property from potential takeovers by large companies. All these changes have been recommended and written by our attorney. Governing document changes require membership approval to pass; we need 2/3 of The total voting interests to agree to the changes in order to get them passed and updated. There are 3 separate documents that comprise our governing documents needing changes; therefore, this mailing will contain 3 consent forms. There will be information included showing you the recommended changes. Once you receive this mailing, these consent forms need to be signed and returned as soon as possible.

If you have any questions on any of these mailings, please call an HOA board member and we will be happy to explain these changes and process.

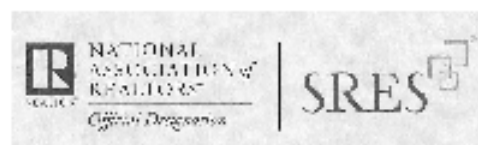
