RECIPIE OF THE MONTH

English Trifle

Angel food cake

Sherry, rum, port or some kind pf sweet juice

1 Package of Jello, any flavor, prepared as per package instruction

1 Package of vanilla instant pudding, prepared as per package Cool Whip

Fresh fruit such as strawberries, peaches, pears or blueberries

Layer 1: 1 Angel food cake broken into pieces, in a large clear glass bowl. Pour sherry, rum or port over the cake, stirring it in and letting the cake absorb it and ensuring the cake is moist. Substitute a sweet juice if you prefer a non-alcoholic dessert, although sherry is traditional.

Layer 2: Prepare any Jello gelatin dessert according to the package. Pour it over the cake and refrigerate to let it set. Layer 3: Prepare the vanilla instant pudding according to the package. Must be cold. Pour over the Jello and refrigerate for 30 minutes. This layer can be prepared with English custard if desired, or it may be after the fruit layer if you wish.

Layer 4: Any kind of mixed fresh fruit.

Layer 5: Enough Cool Whip (or whipped heavy cream) to cover the top.

Keep refrigerated until ready to serve. When serving, try and get each layer in each serving. - Frankie Alexander




